What you can put in the trash station

● **Trash that is separated improperly cannot be collected.**

● Place your trash in a clear or translucent bag and dispose of it at the designated trash station.

★ There have been instances of residents putting trash into trash stations on days other than the designated collection days. Please dispose of trash only on the designated collection days, as not doing so can lead to trash that should not be collected on that day getting mixed in with other types of trash, which can interfere with collection operations.

The following burnable trash can be brought directly to Tatebayashi Clean Center. (Fees apply)

Burnable trash

- Disposable diapers:** Flush waste in toilet before disposing.
- Sneakers, leather shoes, pumps:** Remove laces.
- Rubber hoses:** (cut into short pieces)
- Cloth, leather & plastic bags:** Remove fixtures.
- Vegetable waste, fish bones, shells, etc.:** Drain thoroughly to reduce water content.
- Trees & pruned branches:**
 - Tie up with string.
 - Diameter up to 3cm
 - Length up to 40cm
 - *For pruned branches larger than those listed above, up to 10cm in diameter and 2m in length, please bring them directly to Tatebayashi Clean Center.

Aluminum foil, Disposable heat packs, Desiccants (silica gel, etc.), Fallen leaves & grass (dry thoroughly), Stuffed animals & floor cushions (up to approx. 40cm square), Tissue paper, etc.
 *Dispose of soiled used paper and plastic containers & packaging with lingering stains or odors as "Burnable trash".

The following bottles, cans, and dangerous items can be brought directly to Itakura Recycle Center. (Fees apply)

Bottles

Remove lid and be sure to remove contents
 • Dispose of plastic caps with "Plastic containers & packaging"
 • Dispose of aluminum and steel caps with "Cans"

Cans

Food cans: Remove contents from food cans.
 Beer & soft drink cans: Lightly rinse inside.
 Spray cans: Use all contents before disposing.
 • Dispose of plastic caps with "Plastic containers & packaging"
 • Dispose of aluminum and steel caps with "Cans"

Dangerous items

Ceramics (including broken items), Glass (broken), Bottles (broken), Small metal pieces, etc.

What you can put in the recyclables station

● Please put everything in its proper container, receptacle, or net.

● Containers, receptacles, and nets for collection are set up the day before the collection day and collected together with recyclables on the collection day.

The following recyclables can be brought directly to Itakura Recycle Center. (Fees apply)

Small home appliances (30cm or less)

Calculators, Telephones, Boomboxes, Hair dryers, Home game systems
 *Small home appliances are electrical appliances used in the home that run on batteries or electricity. Make sure to remove any batteries before disposing.
 *Remove any batteries and delete any data that contains personal information.

Old paper

Magazines, Newspapers, Paper scraps, Cardboard
 *In the event of rain, put out on the next collection day if possible. (Your cooperation with group collection is appreciated.) *Place directly at the collection site. *Dispose of paper with waterproof processing as "Burnable trash"

Plastic containers & packaging

Instant noodle containers, etc., Polystyrene and other corrosion-resistant materials, Box lunch containers, White trays, Plastic (30cm or less), Hangers, Cups, Rulers, Plastic models, Toothbrushes
 *Items with the plastic recycling mark
 *Dispose of any items with lingering stains or odors as "Burnable trash".

PET bottles

Remove the cap, Remove the label, Rinse out the inside, Crush
 Dispose of caps and labels with "Plastic containers & packaging"
 *You can also dispose of PET bottles at the Community Center.

The "Plastic containers & packaging" trash generated when products are disposed of is often placed in recyclables collection boxes at stores that handle such products. These stores also participate in recycling efforts. "The items you buy go to the collection box when you replace them."

Trash that can be brought to the Community Center

● Items that can be brought during opening hours: 8:30-17:15 (closed on Mondays and over the New Year holiday period)

Paper cartons, Dry-cell batteries (only used-up batteries), PET bottles
 *Rechargeable batteries are collected at collection boxes at retailers and mass-merchandise stores.

● Items that can be brought in only on the 1st & 3rd Wednesdays

Fluorescent tubes, Used cooking oil
 *Take them out of the bag, etc. and place them in the designated receptacle.
 *Pour into a PET bottle, etc. with the cap tightly closed, and put in the designated receptacle.

What you can bring to Tatebayashi Clean Center (incineration facility)

Burnable trash

See "Burnable trash" above

Burnable oversized trash

Items not containing metal or glass (remove all glass or metal parts when bringing in for disposal)

- Futons, Floor cushions, Tables, Shelves
- Tatami mats, Carpets, Rugs, Sliding paper doors, Plywood, Cupboards (no metal or glass), Chairs (with no metal parts), Reed screens (length up to 2m), Corrugated iron & sheeting (plastic), Mattresses (foam rubber type only), etc.

*Items with metal or glass parts are non-burnable oversized trash. Please bring them to Itakura Recycle Center.

What you can bring to Itakura Recycle Center (facility for recycling non-burnable trash and recyclables)

Non-burnable trash & oversized trash

Metal (aluminum, steel), glass, ceramics, etc.

- Bicycles, Mattresses with springs, Glass & ceramics, Fryng pans & pots, Gas stoves, Kettles, Lighters
- Kotatsu heated tables, Space heaters, Sofas, Glass tables, Cupboards (with metal or glass), Massage chairs, Zaisu floor chairs, Ski equipment, Tatami mats, Carpets, Rugs, Steel ladders, Steel racks, Electric carpets, Child car seats, Strollers, Umbrellas, Corrugated iron & sheeting (metal), etc., Lighters (remove gas before disposing)

Recyclables

See "Recyclables" above

- Old paper (newspapers, magazines, cardboard, scrap paper), Plastic containers & packaging, Home appliances (not including the 4 basic home appliances & PCs), Printers, Cloth (clothing, sheets, curtains, etc.), Blankets, Cans, Bottles, PET bottles, Fluorescent tubes, Dry-cell batteries, Plastic, etc.

 (The facilities' phone reception has been streamlined)

Itakura Recycle Center & Tatebayashi Clean Center require fees for disposal.
 Each item handled can be brought to the facilities shown above. When doing so, the weight is measured in 10kg units according to the weight displayed on the facility's scale. If the total amount brought to all facilities in one month exceeds 100kg per household, a fee of ¥20 per 1kg plus consumption tax will be applied to the total amount. However, if the total displayed weight is 90kg or less in one month, no fees will apply.
 Example: When the total weight is 100kg: 100kg x ¥20/kg + consumption tax = ¥2,000 plus consumption tax

Trash that the town cannot dispose of

● The items below cannot be disposed of by the town. Please dispose of them at a retailer or a specialized company. Please note that trash generated from the business activities of shops, businesses, cafeterias, agriculture, etc. cannot be disposed of at local trash stations.

- Automobiles, motorcycles (including parts), Tires, Syringes & other medical waste, Batteries, Paint, Construction waste (concrete blocks, ceramic & stone tiles, building wall materials, etc.), Fire extinguishers, Used oil & pesticides, PCs, TVs, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers, air conditioners (the 4 basic home appliances)

A fee is required for recycling these appliances. For more information, please contact the store where you purchased the item or the Home Appliance Recycling Ticket Center (0120-319640).

*The items listed above are for example purposes. Please contact us if you have any questions. *In the case of burnable and non-burnable oversized trash, there is an assistance program for physically disabled persons and those who do not have a driver's license in which we will come to your home to collect it for a fee. (The home collection fee is in addition to the disposal fees described above.)
